

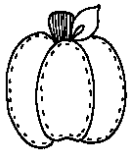
Fall Harvest Tours at Trax Farms

Bring your class to Trax Farms for an educational tour on a working farm.

Dates:

Tours will begin on September 22, 2008 and conclude on October 31, 2008. One-hour day tours will take place Monday through Friday from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Please ask if you need another time.

Activities:

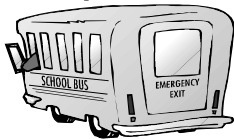


The guided tour includes: an educational hayride through our decorated fruit and vegetable fields (30 per wagon), an inside peek at a working bee hive, a produce washer demonstration, a tour through our produce cooler and a seasonal vegetable lecture. Please allow extra time for children to have goodies and enjoy our on-your-own activities like the cornstalk maze and play area.

Goodies:

Each paying person will receive an apple, sample of cider, and a 3-5 pound pumpkin. In addition teachers will receive an educational packet.

Transportation:



Buses are best. Car pools should arrive together to insure a speedy check-in. All groups are asked to meet outside at the Fall Tours sign in our parking lot. **Plan to arrive at least 15 minutes prior to your scheduled tour time.**

Fees:

To help defray costs, there is a \$6.00 charge per person. Please collect all money in advance and make one payment for the entire group. Payment due on your tour day, 15 minutes prior to start time.

Tours are by reservation only! **To schedule a tour, please go to our website www.traxfarms.com click on the Fall Tours Tab.** When scheduling, please have the following information ready: Group name, address, phone and cell #, approximate count of children *and* adults. We welcome any groups planning to stay through lunch. However, you must notify us when scheduling your tour so that we can allocate space for your group!
